



Broadwindsor Group Parish Community Land Trust

Update, March 2019

The Broadwindsor Group Parish Community Land Trust held its AGM in Drimpton Village Hall on Monday, 18 March 2019. The CLT's Chair, David Leader, brought the membership up-to-date on the current project status: legal negotiations are almost concluded, and the CLT is hopeful that a Planning Application might be submitted by the end of this month.

Louise Lote, Senior Land Manager with Yarlington Housing Group, gave a presentation highlighting successful CLT projects which they have delivered since 2012, and then took questions.

The meeting then looked at possible future community projects which might benefit from CLT involvement.

Suggestions included:

- provision of light industrial units for local employment
- creation of a community orchard
- establishment of a skills exchange register or workshop.

Members were invited to submit their ideas for consideration.

Election to the Board. David Leader and Jacqui Sewell stood down and both were unanimously re-elected. Emma Costin of Drimpton had also been nominated for Board membership and the meeting unanimously approved her appointment.

Meeting closed at approximately 20.30 p.m.
